

UK Horseracing Stalls Bias Systems AW 2011/2012 Season

This document shows where and under what circumstances the Stalls Bias 10% and 20% can be utilised to good effect for the AW season in 2011/2012.

Lingfield is the only course that offers no stalls bias whatsoever.

This has been compiled for the use of members of UK Horseracing, and selections can be found manually or from using the system filters on the bot.

Please note that ALL results shown are to BFSP and after the maximum 5% deductions.

The courses each have two pages of results data for each bias. The first page is for results from January 2008 to the end of September 2011, and the second page is an updated version that included results from October 2011 as well.

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What it all means

Dundalk 10% Stalls Bias January 2008 to end of September 2011

Dundalk is the sole course in IRE that has AW racing, and over the few years the course has seen action, some form of stalls bias has surfaced. The general result for the 10% bias is 121 wins from 1410 selections showing a loss of 64pts.

There are some very good profitable angles however at this track as shown in the table below, despite some lower SR's. Of serious note though is the performance of Top Rated with a 25% SR and 16% ROI when running from a good stall.

Dundalk 20% Stalls Bias January 2008 to end of September 2011

Limited data for Dundalk 20% stalls bias with just 297 selections to work with. These produced 25 winners and a loss of 52pts.

As is often the case though, some interesting areas in which to exploit the bias.

Kempton 10% Stalls Bias January 2008 to end of September 2011

Kempton has a big stalls bias over 5-7f races. We would not put anyone off backing any horse running from a 10% stall at big odds as this has produced some huge winners already this season that are not included in the results as yet. The full result for period January 2008 to October 2011 is not actually that impressive with 472 wins from over 4000 runners and a loss well in excess of over 400pts.

However, as you can see in the table below it is not all bad and we have plenty to work with.

Kempton 20% Stalls Bias January 2008 to end of September 2011

The 20% stalls bias at Kempton offers the very rare opportunity to simply back every such runner and walk away with a profit. From 1162 selections there have been 164 winners and a profit of some 62pts, extending to over 80pts if using the UKHR Value price. In the table below, we have included some of the better systems here from dozens of possible.

Southwell 10% Stalls Bias January 2008 to end of September 2011

Southwell, like Kempton, offers us a rare chance of backing every 10% stall runner and coming away with a profit. We are surprised at the findings for Southwell and as can see in the table below there are some very good opportunities here to take advantage of the stalls bias.

Southwell 20% Stalls Bias January 2008 to end of September 2011

Limited data for 20% stalls bias at Southwell but once again an overall profit is to be had if backing every runner with 40 winners from 308 runners. These will mainly be from the low stalls in the sprint races. Once again, being selective can reap better rewards as shown in the table below.

Wolverhampton 10% Stalls Bias January 2008 to end of September 2011

The 10% Stalls Bias at Wolverhampton does not look too impressive at first glance with 313 wins from 2890 runs and a loss of over 400pts.

However, despite this, some hidden gems have been unearthed that can be used throughout the AW season.

Wolverhampton 20% Stalls Bias January 2008 to end of September 2011

The 20% Stalls Bias at Wolverhampton are quite limited in where they are profitable but there are some areas worthy of inclusion.

The full results for these are 83 wins from 662 selections showing a loss of 74pts.

But, the table below indicates that we can make some hay with these in the right places.

What it all means

There are various terms used in this production and details of these are shown below. Long term members of UKHR will need no introduction to these but for new members it is useful to know exactly what we are talking about.

Age

This is the age of the horse that is to be backed

Race Class

UKHR has their own race class and these are shown at the top of the ratings. Class $\geq 80 < 90$ means the horse to back are in class of race between 80 and 90 only. Other classes indicate the class of race in which to back.

Furlongs

This is the race distance in which to play.

U

U means underscore type. Generally there are twelve underscores on the ratings (shown with a dark line underneath the field) So, if a system shows U WinF as an example you would back horse that have the WinF underscored.

Rating Rank

This is where the horse is rated, in this document either Top Rated or 2nd Rated.

TC, TJC, TJ or JC

Some systems are for All Profitable TC for example. This means that the selection must be for a horse that has a profitable Trainer at the course. These are easily located next to the horses name under Systems.

Rank

Every horse in each race has a ranked field. This could be for Raw, RAdj, in fact all twelve of the underscores. So, if a system is flagged as Rank Raw for example, the horse to back is one that is in the TOP THREE of that field.

Handicaps, Stakes, Claimers or Selling

These are the race types in which some systems require. An example of this is Southwell 20% stalls bias where one system is in Claiming races only, another in Selling races and another in ALL Stakes (non handicaps) races.

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
